THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, PURSUANT TO LAW, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE BOARD WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY THE COUNTY AUDITOR, R. W. SAFSTROM, AND PROCEEDED TO ORGANIZE FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

THE OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE WAS ADMINISTERED TO THE FOLLOWING COMMISSIONERS WHO WERE ELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 5, 1946:

H. C. LOUDEN, 1ST DISTRICT; A. Z. NELSON, 2ND DISTRICT; ELMER WALSTEAD, 3RD DISTRICT.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MOVED THAT THE CHAIRMAN FOR THE ENSUING YEAR BE ELECTED BY SECRET BALLOT. COMMISSIONER MEINHARDT SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO BALLOT WITH THE RESULT THAT H. C. LOUDEN RECEIVED A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES, AND HE WAS OFFICIALLY DECLARED CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD FOR THE YEAR 1947.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING OF THE BOARD WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

IT WAS MOVED BY COMMISSIONER DAWSON THAT THE ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR AS PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 11-1136, 1943 REVISED CODE, BE ADOPTED BY THE BOARD.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COMMISSIONER NELSON THAT ELMER WALSTEAD BE APPOINTED COURTHOUSE COMMISSIONER FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER MEINHARDT SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER DAWSON THAT EACH COMMISSIONER BE APPOINTED ROAD AND BRIDGE COMMISSIONER IN AND FOR HIS OWN DISTRICT, WITH POWER TO CALL TO HIS ASSISTANCE OTHER COMMISSIONERS TO ACT WITH HIM WHEN NECESSARY.

COMMISSIONER MEINHARDT SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD MADE A MOTION THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR BE AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PAY BY AUDITOR'S WARRANTS, ALL SALARIES AND CLERK HIRE AS FIXED BY THE BOARD AND APPROVED IN THE VARIOUS BUDGET REQUESTS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, 1947 AND JANITORS SALARIES AS SET BY THE BOARD OR BY LEGISLATIVE ENACTMENT; ALSO ALL ORDERS PRESENTED BY THE COUNTY PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD TO BE PAID OUT OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE FUND, ALSO ALL AMOUNTS DUE THE STATE PUBLIC WELFARE BOARD OF NORTH DAKOTA AND THE RURAL REHABILITATION CORPORATION OR ITS SUCCESSORS AND SARGENT COUNTY OF COLLECTIONS MADE FOR LIVESTOCK FEED ASSISTANCE LOANS.

COMMISSIONER NELSON SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON MOVED THAT DR. F. G. HUBBARD BE APPOINTED SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

COMMISSIONER MEINHARDT SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

IT WAS MOVED BY COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD THAT THE SALARY OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH BE FIXED AT \$300.00 FOR THE ENSUING YEAR, SAME BEING THE MINIMUM AMOUNT PROVIDED BY LAW, AND THAT THE MILEAGE BE FIXED AT 5 CENTS PER MILE NECESSARILY TRAVELED.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE BOARD NEXT PROCEEDED TO CONSIDER THE APPOINTMENT OF INSANITY COMMISSIONER.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON MOVED THAT A. LESLIE BE APPOINTED INSANITY COMMISSIONER FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE AUDITOR REPORTED THAT THERE HAD BEEN FILED IN HIS OFFICE, THE OFFICIAL OATH OF OFFICE OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS, ELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOV. 5, 1946, AND THAT HE HAD ON FILE CERTIFICATIONS FROM THE STATE BONDING DEPARTMENT THAT SAID OFFICERS HAD BEEN DULY BONDED BY THE SAID STATE BONDING DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW:
