THE TERM " CONSTRUCTION COSTS " SMALL MEAN THOSE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE ACTUAL BUILDING AND ALL EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE COMSTRUCTION SUCH AS PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING, COST OF ADVERTISING, COSTS FOR FIELD AND LABORATORY TESTS AND RECORD TESTING, COST FOR PRINTING OF PLANS AND THE COST OF ALL OTHER WORK NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

- 3. THE COUNTY AGREES TO KEEP RECORDS AND FURNISH COPIES THEREOF OR KEEP OPEN TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS ALL RECORDS AND FILES PERTAINING TO THE PROJECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEAPRIMENT TO OBTAIN IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL PARTICIPATION.
 - 4. THE COUNTY WILL, AT ITS EXPENSE AND WITHOUT FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT, ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF-WAY.
- 5. ADEQUATE ENGINEERING, SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY UNDER THE GENERAL DIRECTION OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND THE COUNTY SHALL MAKE SUCH REPORTS, KEEP SUCH RECORDS AND PERFORM SUCH WORK IN THE MANNER AND TIME AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST AND DIRECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT, AS THE AGENT OF THE COUNTY TO COLLECT FOR THE COUNTY THE FEDERAL-AID EARNED.
- 6. It is Agreed that the County shall have sole reponibility to see that the required number of samples are TAKEN IN A SATISFACTORY MANNER AND PROPERLY SUBMITTED FOR TESTING BY OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DEMARTMENT'S TESTING LABORATORY AT BISMARCK, NORTH DAKOTA OF ALL MATERIALS TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT ANDSIMILARLY FOR THOSE RECORD TESTS OF THE COMPLETED PROJECTS AS REQUIRED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OR ITS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES AND THE DEPARTMENT.

7. FEDERAL FUNDS WILL ONLY PARTICIPATE IN WORK PERFORMED SUBSEQUENT TO AUTHORIZATION BY THE DISTRICT ENGINEER OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS AND THE DEPARTMENT.

8. An engineering and clerical change of 1 % of the total cost of the project will be made by the State Highway Department which the county agrees to pay upon completion of the project(s).

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND THE COUNTY AUDIT OR ARE HERBBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT. COMMISSIONER ENGE SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER ENGE MOVED THAT THE COUNTY ENTER INTO THE FOLLOWING MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT:
