

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment with Commissioners Bruns, Chesley, Enge, Lee and Orth present.

The meeting was called to order by Ralph Seavert, County Auditor and the Board proceeded to organize for the ensuing year.

Commissioner Enge moved that Commissioner Bruns serve as Chairman for the ensuing year. Commissioner Orth seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Lee moved that Commissioner Enge serve as Vice Chairman for the ensuing year. Commissioner Orth seconded the motion and same carried.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and on motion approved as read.

Motion by Commissioner Enge and seconded by Commissioner Lee that Commissioner Orth serve as Courthouse Commissioner for the ensuing year. Motion carried.

Commissioner Chesley moved that Donald J. Feist M.D. be appointed Superintendent of the Board of Health for Sargent County for the ensuing year, salary to be \$150.00 per year plus mileage as prescribed by law.

Commissioner Lee seconded the motion and same carried.

Motion by Commissioner Enge and seconded by Commissioner Orth that Robert A. Case be re-appointed to the Sargent County Mental Health Board, term ending 1st Monday in January 1972. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Chesley and seconded by Commissioner Enge that the County Treasurer be given authority to destroy all unused 1968 personal property receipts. Motion carried.

The Board proceeded to open sealed proposals for the deposit of Public Funds. Proposals were submitted by the Sargent County Bank of Forman, the First National Bank of Milnor and the Bank of North Dakota of Bismarck.

Commissioner Lee moved that the Sargent County Bank of Forman, the First National Bank of Milnor and the Bank of North Dakota of Bismarck be designated as legal depositories of County Funds for the years 1970 and 1971.

Commissioner Chesley seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Chesley moved that the Public Depository Agreement for pledge of assets as security for County funds in the Sargent County Bank of Forman and the First National Bank of Milnor be approved as to sufficiency according to law.

Commissioner Enge seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Enge moved that the County Auditor be instructed to call for sealed bids in the Official Newspaper for the furnishing of supplies, purchase of culverts, gravel Etc. for the period beginning April 1st, 1970 and ending March 31st, 1971. Bids to be opened March 18th, 1970 as follows: Election Supplies 9:45 A.M.; Culverts 10:00 A.M.; Bridge plank 10:30 A.M.; Cutting Edges 11:00 A.M.; Oil, Grease & Fuel supplies 1:30 P.M.; Rental of Bridge Equipment 2:00 P.M.; Rental of Highway Equipment 2:30 P.M.; Screening, Crushing, Loading and Hauling Gravel 3:00 P.M.

Commissioner Lee seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Enge moved that the following amounts of delinquent personal property taxes, same having been found uncollectable, be cancelled in the various taxing districts as follows: Harlem Township \$4.40; Shuman Township \$2.32; Verner Township \$5.16; Milnor City \$12.41.

Commissioner Lee seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Enge moved that the Sargent County Highway Employees receive an increase in pay of \$25.00 per month effective January 1st, 1970.

Commissioner Orth seconded the motion and same carried.

Commissioner Chesley introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Chapter 57-22-21 of the North Dakota Century Code provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall at its January meeting, declare by resolution that all unpaid and uncanceled personal property taxes shall constitute a lien on any real estate owned by the tax debtor, from and after the date of extension and entry thereof by the County Auditor upon the tax list of the next proceeding year, opposite the descriptions of real estate designated by the Board of County Commissioners, belonging to any person, Company or Corporation owing such uncollected personal property taxes, the year or years for which the tax remains due and the principal sum of such tax and that such entry shall be made without regards to any prior payment of real estate taxes on said descriptions for the proceeding year, and the County Treasurer shall be without authority thereafter to issue any receipt in full for said real estate taxes without making collection at the same time, the personal property taxes so extended; a taxpayer holding a specific lien on said descriptions ahead of personal property taxes charged thereon shall be entitled to a tax receipt without regards to non-payment of such inferior personal property taxes and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that all unpaid and uncollected delinquent personal property taxes from and after the date of extension and entry thereof as provided in the foregoing minutes, shall constitute a lien on any real estate owned by the tax delinquent, or which may thereafter be acquired by the tax delinquent and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following personal property taxes owed shall be a specific lien upon the property described as follows:


