Sparky Engquist, Road Superintendent, arrived at 11:00 Lysle Coleman; Crete arrived at 11:15. Mr. Coleman inquired about gravel on roadways in Verner Township and repairs to the road north of Crete. Sparky Engquist explained what is planned for these roadways, and the projected timeline for commencing the work. Mr. Engquist also reported that the portion of County #2, south of Crete that had been closed all summer due to flooding from Kraft Slough has now been raised above the water and reopened.
