Forman, North Dakota December 19, 2023

The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 with the following members present: Wade Anderson, Jason Arth, Lyle Bopp, Mark Breker, and Scott Johnson. Also present was Jayne Pfau, State's Attorney and Pam Maloney, County Auditor.

Chairman Scott Johnson called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Motion to accept the agenda as amended. (Arth/Breker) Motion carried.

Motion to approve the December 5, 2023 minutes. (Anderson/Bopp) Motion carried.

Brenda Peterson, Health Unit Administrator, arrived at the meeting to continue the discussion from last month regarding the health unit's temporary employees. Motion to approve adding the following to the Sargent County Handbook Policy 202 Employment Categories: Sargent County District Health Unit temporary employees, employed beyond one year, may receive employer's other benefit programs and/or pay increases as approved by the Sargent County District Board of Health paid through the grant or program funding the temporary position. (Bopp/Arth) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Luke Siemieniewski, Todd Stein & Wendy Willprecht, Sargent County Water Resource District; and Tim Faber, Road Supervisor; arrived at the meeting. Discussion was held regarding applications and permits from the county and the water resource board for drainage, tiling, etc. The water resource board provided an application that is being used in Barnes County, which is very similar to the application the county commissioners already use for county road right-of-way work. The auditor will send the county application to the water resource board for their review to hopefully work out a solution for both boards to use for the permitting process. These applications would also be something that the townships would be able to use, as well.

The two boards discussed briefly the Supreme Court judgement ruling again the water resource district.

Jim Kaiser, National Weather Service of Grand Forks, arrived at the meeting. Sargent County has been designated as a Storm Ready county. This is a National Weather Service program designed to recognize communities that have reached a high level of severe weather preparedness. To be recognized as Storm Ready, a community must meet criteria established jointly between the NWS and state and local emergency management officials. He presented a sign and certificate to Wendy Willprecht, Emergency Manager, who has done the work to achieve this status.

The commission received a request from the City of Milnor that the county send a letter of support for Milnor City's Transportation Alternative Grant application. Motion to authorize the chairman to sign a letter of support for the Milnor City TAP project. Milnor City's project includes new sidewalk along the north end of Main Street adjoining homes along this street and connecting to the residential subdivision on the north side of Milnor. There are no sidewalks or paths in this area and pedestrians walk on the street. (Anderson/Breker) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Motion to approve a Raffle Permit to the Sargent County Snowmobile Association for raffle to be held March 13, 2024. (Breker/Arth) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Approve transfer among the following 2023 budget funds: (Arth/Bopp) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

From General to Courthouse Building Improvement \$ 25,000.00 From Recorder's Document Preservation to General \$ 4,251.78 From General to Fairground Improvement \$ 2,019.56 Trent Mahler, Forman Ambulance Squad Coordinator, arrived at the meeting. He provided the commissioner with his checkbook balance and upcoming bills that will need to be paid. He is requesting \$5000 to assist him with the bills. Motion to approve giving the Forman Ambulance Squad \$5000 to be paid out of the EMS fund. (Breker/Bopp) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously. Mr. Mahler stated that the squad is planning a fundraiser pancake breakfast the last Sunday in January. He also reported that the ambulance squad has formed a board and did approve the county taking over the accounting bookwork beginning in January.

Motion to authorize the chairman and auditor to sign the county deeds for the properties that were sold at the November tax sale. (Bopp/Anderson) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Travis Paeper, Sheriff, arrived at the meeting. There was much discussion regarding the county's cell phone reimbursement policy. He suggested that the policy be reviewed again.

Tim Faber, Road Supervisor; and Damon DeVillers, Interstate Engineering; arrived at the meeting. Mr. DeVillers presented the commission with an estimate for five minor structure replacements at a cost of 3,632,178.25 that would be eligible for the Flex Funding Grant from the state. Motion to request flex funding for two bridges – Bridge 41-121-23.0 on County Road #7 and Bridge 41-135-5.0 on County Road #14 – and to agree to a 20% county match for the two projects. (Bopp/Anderson) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Approve December payroll in the sum of \$275,073.54 and the following bills. (Breker/Anderson) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.
