THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA

State Highway Department, Hereinafter referred to as the Highway Department, Hereby agrees as follows:

- 1. That the Highway Department will submit a project for the improvement of 3.994 miles of the County. FEDERAL AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY, BASE, BITUMINOUS SURFACE TREATMENT ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM COGSWELL SOUTH, AND TO BE DESIGNATED AS NORTH DAKOTA PROJECT CS 113(4), AND WILL RECOMMEND ITS APPROVAL BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEMARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR CONSTRUCTION WITH FUNDS APPORTIONED TO THE STATE UNDER THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ACT AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED; SUBJECT, HOWEVER, TO THE CONDITION THAT THE COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE FOR ITS PROPER MIANTENANCE AFTER COMPLETION OF ITS IMPROVEMENT.
- 2. That the SAID County HEREBY REQUESTS THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT THE FOREGOING MENTIONED PROJECT WITH RECOMMENDATION THAT IT BE APPROVED BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED States of America, and agrees that if such project is approved and constructed by the Highway Department and the BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IT THEREAFTER, AT ITS OWN COST AND EXPERSE, WILL MAINTAIN THE PROJECT IN A MANNER SATISFACTORY TO THEM, OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES, AND WILL MAKE AMPLE PROVISION EACH YEAR FOR SUCH MAINTENSINCE,

AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND : 0 DIRECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT.

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION, ON ROLL CALL VOTE, ALL COTMISSIONERS VOTED "AYE". No one voted "MAY" AND THE MOTION WAS DULY DECLARED CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT THE COUNTY ENTER INTO THE FOLLOWING CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT:

THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA

STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE DEPARTMENT, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE DEPARTMENT WILL TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TOWARD SECURING CO-OPERATION WITH THE UNITED STATES GOVERNME IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN TITLE 23 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE AS AMENDED AND SUPPLE-MENTED AND AUTHORIZATION PROVIDED PURSUANT THERETO AND AVAILABLE FOR THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY PROJECT No. 113(4) COUNTY ROAD FROM COGSWELL SOUTH - BASE, BITUMINOUS SURFACE TREATMENT.

2. THE COUNTY WILL PAY ALL CONSTRUCTION COSTS EXCEPT THE AMOUNT PAID BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT (NOT TO EXCEED 50 %) THROUGH THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, AND , IF THE DEPARTMENT ADVANCES ANY PAYMENTS IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY WHICH ARE LATER FOUND MON-COLLECTIBLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, THE COUNTY WILL REIMBURSE THE DEPART-

MENT FOR FUNDS SO ADVANCED.

THE TERM "CONSTRUCTION COSTS" SHALL MEAN THOSE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE ACTUAL BUILDING AND ALL EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE CONSTRUCTION SUCH AS PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING, COST OF ADVERTISING, COSTS FOR FIELD AND LABORATORY TESTS AND RECORD TESTING COST FOR PRINTING OF PLANS AND THE COST OF ALL OTHER WORK NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS. FURTHER THE COUNTY HEREBY CONCURS THAT THIS PROJECT SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CURRENT ADOPTED STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, DESIGN STANDARDS AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS AS RECOMMENDED FOR THIS PROJECT BY THE DEPARTMENT.

3. THE COUNTY AGREES TO KEEP RECORDS AND FURNISH COPIES THEREOF OR KEEP OPEN TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS ALL RECORDS AND FILES PERTAINING TO THE PROJECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT TO OBTAIN IN

BEHALF OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL PARTICIPATION.

4. THE COUNTY WILL AT ITS EXPENSE AND WITHOUT FEDERAL - AID REIMBURSEMENT, ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY RISHTS-OF

- 5. ADEQUATE ENGINEERING, SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY UNDER THE GENERAL AND CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND THE COUNTY SHALL MAKE SUCH REPORTS, KEEP SUCH RECORDS AND PERFORM SUCH WORK IN THE MANNER AND TIME AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST AND DIRECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT, AS THE AGENT OF THE County to collect for the County the Federal-Aid Earned.
- 6. IT IS AGREED THAT THE COUNTY SHALL HAVE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT THE REQUIFED NUMBER OF SAMPLES KEN IN A SATISFACTORY MANNER AND PROPERLY SUBMITTED FOR TESTING BY OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT'S ABE TAKEN IN A SATISFACTORY MANNER AND PROPERLY SUBMITTED FOR ICOTION OF THE PROJECT AND LESTING LIBERT AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT AND LABORATORY AT BIEMARCK, NORTH DAKOTA OF ALL MATERIALS TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT AND SIMILARLY FOR THOSE RECORD TESTS OF THE COMPLETED PROJECT AS REQUIRED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OR ITS AUTHORIZED PEPRESENTATIVES AND THE DEPARTMENT.

7. FEDERAL FUNDS WILL ONLY PARTICIATE IN WORK PERFORMED SUBSECUENT TO AUTHORIZATION BY THE DISTRICT ENGINEER OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS AND THE DEPARTMENT.

8. An engineering and clerical charge of 1 % of the total cost of the project will be made by the State HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WHICH THE COUNTY AGREES TO PAY UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT.

THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE DEPARTMENT, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE DEPARTMENT WILL TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TOWARDS SECURING CO-OPERATION WITH THE UNITED STATES GOVERN-MENT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN TITLE 23 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED AND AUTHORIZATIONS PROVIDED PURSUANT THERETO AND AVIALABLE FOR THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY PROJECT NO. CS 404(2) GRADING, GRAVEL SURFECING ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM COGSWELL NORTH - 4.014 MILES.

2. THE COUNTY WILL PAY ALL CONSTRUCTION COSTS EXCEPT THE AMOUNT PAID BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT (NOT TO EXCEED 50 %) THROUGH THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, AND, IF THE DEPARTMENT ADVANCES ANY PAYMENTS IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY WHICH ARE LATER FOUND NON-COLLECTIBLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, THE COUNTY WILL REIMBURBE THE

DEPARTMENT FOR FUNDS SO ADVANCED.

THE TERM " CONSTRUCTION COSTS " SHALL MEAN THOSE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE ACTUAL BUILDING AND ALL EXPENSE INCIDENTAL TO THE CONSTRUCTION BUCH AS PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING, COST OF ADVERTIBING, COSTS FOR FIELD AND LABORATORY TESTS AND RECORD TESTING, COST FOR PRINTING OF PLANS AND THE COST OF ALL OTHER WORK NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS. FURTHER, THE COUNTY HEREBY CONCURS THAT THIS PROJECT SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CURRENT ADOPTED STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS, DESIGN STANDARDS AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS AS RECOMMENDED FOR THIS PROJECT BY THE DEPARTMENT.

3. THE COUNTY AGREES TO KEEP RECORDS AND FURNISH COPIES THEREOF OR KEEP OPEN TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS ALL RECORDS AND FILES PERTAINING TO THE PROJECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT TO OBTAIN IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL PARTICIPATION.

4. THE COUNTY WILL AT ITS EXPENSE AND WITHOUT FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT, ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY RISHTS-OF-WAY. 5. ADEQUATE ENGINEERING, SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY UNDER THE GENERAL DIR-

ECTION AND CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND THE COUNTY SHALL MAKE SUCH REPORTS, KEEP SUCH RECORDS AND PERFORM SUCH WORK IN THE MANNER AND TIME AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST AND DIRECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT, AS THE AGENT OF THE COUNTY TO COLLECT FOR THE COUNTY THE FEDERAL- AID EARNED.

6. IT IS AGREED THAT THE COUNTY SHALL HAVE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF SAMPLES ARE TAKEN IN A SATISFACTORY MANNER AND PROPERLY SUBMITTED FOR TESTING BY OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT! TESTING LABORATORY, BISMARCK, NORTH DAKOTA OF ALL MATERIALS TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT AND SIMILARLY FOR THOSE RECORD TESTS OF THE COMPLETED PROJECT AS REQUIRED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF ITS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES AND THE DEPARTMENT.

7. FEDERAL FUNDS WILL, ONLY PARTICIPATE IN WORK PERFORMED SUBSEQUENT TO AUTHORIZATION BY THE DISTRICT ENGINEE OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS AND THE DEPARTMENT.

8. An Engineering and Clerical Charge of 1 % of the total cost of the project well be made by the State HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WHICH THE COUNTY AGREES TO PAY UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT.

AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND

DIRECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT.

COMMISSIONER SMITH SECONDED THE MOTION. ON ROLL CALLVOTE, ALL CO MISSIONERS VOTED "AYE". No one voted "NAY" AND THE MOTION WAS DULY DECLARED CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT THE COUNTY ENTER INTO THE FOLLOWING MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT:

THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AB THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WILL SUBMIT A PROJECT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 4.014 MILES OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY, GRADE AND GRAVEL SURFACING ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM COGSWELL NORTH, AND TO BE DESIGNATED AS NORTH DAKOTA PROJECT No. CS 404(2), AND WILL RECOMMEND ITS APPROVAL BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNTIED STATES OF AMERICA FOR CONSTRUCTION WITH FUNDS APPORTIONED TO THE STATE UNDER THE FEDERAL HIGH-WAY ACT AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED; SUBJECT, HOWEVER, TO THE CONDITION THAT THE COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE FOR ITS PROPER MAINTENANCE AFTER COMPLETION OF ITS IMPROVEMENT.

2. That the said County Hereby requests the Highway Department to submit the aforementioned project with RECOMMENDATION THAT IT BE APPROVED BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND AGREES THAT IF SUCH PROJECT IS APPROVED AND CONSTRUCTED BY THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IT THEREAFTER, AT ITS OWN COST AND EXPENSE, WILL MAINTAIN THE PROJECT IN A MANNER SATISFACTORY TO THEM, OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES, AND WILL MAKE AMPLE

PROVISION EACH YEAR FOR SUCH MAINTENANCE.

AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIR-ECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT.

Co-missioner Smith seconded the motion. On roll call vote, all Commissioners voted "AYE". No one voted "NAY" AND THE MOTION WAS DULY DECLARED CARRIED.

A discussion was held in regards to the appointment of a County Supervisor of Absessments. Commissioner Coleman moved that Arthur Krohn of Rutland, North Dakota be appointed Sargent County Supervisor OF ASSESSMENTS ON A PART TIME BASIS FOR THE ENSUING YEAR. TERM TO EXPIRE SEPT. 18T, 1964. SALARY TO BE \$10.00 PER DIEM PLUS MILEAGE AND PER DIEM EXPENSE.

COMMISSIONER DEWEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.
