The MOU serves as an agreement that sets forth the general terms and conditions under which the parties will coordinate and cooperate in activities that serve the needs of Sargent County Residents. Motion to authorize the chairman to sign the MOU between Sargent County and NDSU Extension Related to 4-H Youth Development Programming. The commissioners tabled further discussion regarding the Sargent County Water Resource Board's Drain #11 Cost-Share Reimbursement request until April 16 after the State's Attorney has had time to review the Joint Powers Agreement and other documentation pertaining to this request.

Commissioner Johnson received a phone call from a township regarding a bill he had received from an individual for mowing road ditches. The township nor the county requested the work to be done, so the township, nor the county, would be liable for payment to the individual.

Sheriff Paeper arrived at the meeting to briefly discuss placing large rocks on the west side of the courthouse where the handicapped accessible parking is available. This would help prevent any accidental or intentional driving into the courthouse. This was something that was suggested when the security assessment was done. Commissioners Bopp and Anderson stated that they both have large rocks they could use.
