THE CHAIRMAN, COMMISSIONER MARQUETTE REPORTED THAT HE HAD RECEIVED A LETTER FROM XME Mr. S. W. THOMPSON, STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER, ADVISING HIM THAT THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT IS READY TO PROCEED WITH THE SURVEY OF A NEW LOGATION OF STATE HIGHWAY No. 11 ON THE QUARTER LINE FROM A POINT ON STATE HIGHWAY No. 11 AT THE SOUTH CITY LIMITS OF FORMAN AND EXTENDING DUE WEST A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 13 MILES.

THE LETTER FURTHER STATED THAT THE SURVEY COULD BE STARTED IN TWO WEEKS IF AN AGREE-MENT COULD BE REACHED AS TO THE LOCATION OF THE ROAD AND DIVISION OF THE COSTS. II CONSTRUCTED ON THE QUARTER-LINE, ONEMALF MILE SOUTH OF THE SOO LINE RAILROAD AND THAT THE BOARD AGREES TO PAY 50% OF RIGHT OF WAY COSTS.
