- 2. That this board also feels that the best interests of the patrons in the areas involved will not be protected in this annexation proceedings in that in such proceedings, no provision can be made to guarantee transportation or representation on the board of Education of the Lidgerwood Special School District # 28.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF SARGENT COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, BE AUTHORIZED AND INSTRUCTED TO FORWARD THE PETITIONS HEREIN DESCRIBED AND A COPY OF THESE MINUTES TO THE STATE COMMITTEE FOR THE REORGANIZATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS, IF THE SIGNERS OF THE PETITIONS REQUEST HIM TO DO SO.
