REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE, AT JAMESTOWN, N.DAK. AND JAMES MONIE, TEWAUKON REFUGE MANAGER MET WITH THE COMMISSIONERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPLAINING THE WETLANDS ACQUISITION AND EASEMENT PROGRAM.

COMMISSIONER ENGE MOVED THAT THE BOARD TRADE ONE VAC CASE TRACTOR AND MOWER TO FORMAN IMPLEMENT CO. OF FORMAN, N. DAK. FOR ONE WD 6 TRACTOR AND \$500.00 CASH.

COMMISSIONER HOFLEN SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

THE COUNTY OF SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH STATE HIGH-WAY DEPARTMENT, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE DEPARTMENT, HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. THET THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WILL SUBMIT PROJECTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 6.010 MILES OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY - GRAVEL SUBFACING ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM SH 13 SE OF DELAMERE SOUTH AND EAST, AND TO BE DESIGNATED AS NORTH DAKOTA PROJECT NO. CS 767(4), AND 1,284 MILES OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY - GRAVEL SUBFACING ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM SH 13 SE OF DELAMERE SOUTH AND EAST, AND TO BE DESIGNATED AS NORTH DAKOTA PROJECT NO. CS 838(6), AND 6.492 MILES OF THE COUNTY FEDERAL AID SECONDARY HIGHWAY - G-ABE, GRAVEL SURFACING ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM GENESEO NORTH, AND TO BE DESIGNATED AS NORTH DAKOTA PROJECT NO. CS 685(3), AND WILL RECOMMEND THEIR APPROVAL BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR CONSTRUCTION WITH FUNDS APPORTIONED TO THE STATE UNDER THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ACT AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED; SUBJECT, HOWEVER, TO THE CONDITION THAT THE COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE FOR ITS PROPER MAINTENANCE AFTER COMPLETION OF ITS IMPROVEMENT.

2. THAT THE BAID COUNTY HEREBY REQUESTS THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT THE AFOREMENTIONED PROJECTS WITH RECOMMENDATION THAT IT BE APPROVED BY THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITES STATES OF AMERICA, AND AGREED THAT IF SUCH PROJECTS IS APPROVED AND CONSTRUCTED BY THE HIGHMAY DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IT THEREAFTER, AT ITS OWN COST AND EXPENSE WILL MAINTAIN THE PROJECTS IN A MANNER SATISFACTROY TO THEM, OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES, AND WILL MAKE AMPLE PROVISIONS EACH YEAR FOR SUCH MAINTENANCE.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR ARE HERBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT. COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER COLEMAN MOVED THAT THE COUNTY ENTER INTO THE FOLLOWING CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT:

THE COUNTY SARGENT, STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE COUNTY, AND THE NORTH DAKOTA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE DEPARTMENT, AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THE DEPARTMENT WILL TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TOWARDS SECURING CO-OPERATION WITH THE UNITES STATES GOVERNMENT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FEDERAL FUNDS TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN TITLE 23 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED AND AUTHORIZATIONS PROVIDED PURSUANT THERETO AND AVAILABLE FOR THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED FEDERAL-AID SECONDARY PROJECT NOS. CS 767(4), CS 838(6) GRAVEL SUFFACING ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM SH 13 SE OF DELAMERE SOUTH AND EAST, AND PROJECT NO. CS 685(3) GRADE, GRAVEL SUFFACING ON A COUNTY ROAD FROM GENESEO NORTH.
- 2. THE COUNTY WILL PAY ALL CONSTRUCTION COSTS EXCEPT THE AMOUNT (NOT TO EXCEED 50 \$) PAID BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, AND, IF THE DEPARTMENT ADVANCES ANY PAYMENTS IN BE-HALF OF THE COUNTY WHICH ARE LATER FOUND NON-COLLECTIBLE FROM THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS, THE COUNTY WILL REIMBURSE THE DEPARTMENT FOR FUNDS SO ADVANCED. THE TERM CONSTRUCTION COSTS * SHALL MEAN THOSE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE ACTUAL BUILDING AND ALL EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE CONSTRUCTION SUCH AS PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING, COST OF ADVERTISING, COSTS FOR FIELD AND LABORATORY TESTS AND RECORD TESTING, COST FOR PRINTING OF PLANS AND THE COST OF ALL OTHER WORK NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
- 3. THE COUNTY AGREED TO KEEP RECORDS AND FURNISH COPIES THEROF OR KEEP OPEN TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS ALL RECORDS AND FILES PERTAINING TO THE PROJECTS SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT TO OBTAIN IN BEHALF OF THE COUNTY, FEDERAL PARTICIPATION.
 - 4. THE COUNTY WILL, AT 1TS EXPENSE AND WITHOUT FEDERAL/REIMBUREMENT, ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY RIGHTS-OF WAY.

 5. ADEQUATE ENGINEERING, SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY UNDER THE GENERAL DIR-
- 5. ADEQUATE ENGINEERING, SUPERVISION AND INSPECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY UNDER THE GENERAL DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND THE COUNTY SHALL MAKE BUCH REPORTS, KEEP SUCH RECORDS AND PERFORM SUCH WORK IN THE MANNER AND TIME AS THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST AND DIRECT SO AS TO ENABLE THE DEPARTMENT, AS THE AGENT OF THE COUNTY TO COLLECT FOR THE COUNTY THE FEDERAL AID EARNED.
- 6. It is agreed that the County small have sole reponsibility to see that the required number of samples are taken in a satisfactory manner and properly submitted for testing by or under the supervision of the Department's Testing Laboratory at Bismarck, N. Dak., of all materials to be incorporated into the construction of the project and similarly for those record tests of the completed projects as required at the discretion of the Bureau of Public Roids or its authorized representatives and the Department.
- 7. FEDERAL FUND WILL ONLY PARTICIATE IN WORK PERFORMED BUBSEQUENT TO AUTHORIZATION BY THE DISTRICT ENGINEER OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS AND THE DEPARTMENT.
- 8. AN ENGINEERING AND CLERICAL CHARGE OF 1 % OF THE TOTAL COST OF THE PROJECT WILL BE MADE BY THE STATE

HIGHWAY BENARTMENT WHICH THE COUNTY AGREES TO PAY UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROJECTS.

THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR ARE HERBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO SIGN THIS AGREEMENT.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

A LETTER FROM THE COGSWELL GUN CLUB WAS PRESENTED TO THE COMMISSIONERS.

After considerable discussion the following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Coleman and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS; AFTER CONSIDERING THE AMOUNT OF TIME, MONEY INVESTED, AND THE AMOUNT OF PHYSICAL LABOR EXTENDED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE COGSWELL GUN CLUB IN REFERENCE TO THEIR BUFFALO FARM PROJECT, THAT THIS GROUP ASSEMBLED HERE TO-DAY, DO COMMEND THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COGSWELL GUN CLUB FOR THEIR INTERSE INTEREST IN SUCCESSFULLY ESTABLISHING IN OUR COUNTY A PROJECT SUCH AS THIS. WE FURTHER COMMEND THEM FOR THE EXCELLENT CARE AND SUPERVISION BEING GIVEN TO THIS HERD OF BUFFALO.
