THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, PURSUANT TO LAW, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE READ AND ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS READ.

ON MOTION THE BOARD APPROVED THE REPORT OF SHERIFF A. B. CHRISTIANSEN OF DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES COLLECTED DURING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$709.36.

THE SURETY BOND OF THE GLOBE-GAZETTE PRINTING COMPANY, FURNISHED IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR CONTRACT TO FURNISH ELECTION AND OTHER OFFICE SUPPLIES FOR 1948, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000.00, WITH THE NATIONAL SURETY CORPORATION AS SURETY, HAVING BEEN APPROVED AS TO FORM BY THE STATES ATTORNEY, WAS ON MOTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD AS TO SUFFICIENCY.

COMMISSIONER WALSTEAD SECONDED THE MOTION AND SAME CARRIED.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON MOVED THAT THE COUNTY TREASURER BE AUTHORIZED TO ACCEPT THE ORIGINAL AMOUNT OF THE TAXES FOR THE YEARS 1930 TO 1936 INCLUSIVE AGAINST THE NW^{1/4} OF SEC. 16-129-55, AS SETTLEMENT IN FULL OF SAID TAXES.

CHARLES GLASSER, OF THE GLASSER BRIDGE COMPANY, MET WITH THE BOARD IN REGARD TO BRIDGE WORK.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON MOVED THAT THE BOARD ALLOW THE APPLICATION OF FRED W. THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT THEIR OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE, IN SPECIAL SESSION, CALLED AT THE REQUEST OF THE SARGENT COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONFERRING IN REGARD TO FLOOD PROBLEMS ON BI-COUNTY DRAIN No. 3, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

PRESENT ALSO WERE DRAIN COMMISSIONERS MILTON BERGSJOE, RAY WOHLWEND AND SOIL CONSERVATION ENGINEERS DRESSSEL AND LINFORD.

THE MATTER OF BUILDING DIKES WAS CONSIDERED BUT IT WAS THE OPINION OF THOSE PRESENT THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DID NOT HAVE AUTHORITY TO DO THIS TYPE OF WORK.

BOTH BOARDS WERE IN COMPLETE AGREEMENT THAT THIS DITCH WAS NOT PROPERLY BUILT ORIGINALLY AND THAT FOR THIS REASON IT HAS FOR THE PAST YEARS FLOODED AN AREA OF ABOUT 2000 ACRES IN THE SPRING, BY OVERFLOWING ITS BANKS.

AS THE LAW RESTRICTS BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO JUST CLEANING OUT DRAINAGE DITCHES, AND IT WAS THE OPINION OF THE BOARD THAT MERELY CLEANING OUT THIS DRAIN TO CONFORM WITH ORIGINAL SPECIFICATIONS, WOULD NOT BE SUFFICIENT TO PREVENT THE LAND FROM BEING FLOODED, NO ACTION IN THIS MATTER WAS TAKEN.




