THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

COMMISSIONER GEO. C. DAWSON OFFERED THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION, AND, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER THEO. HOFLEN, MOVED ITS ADOPTION:

WHEREAS, THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT CONTEMPLATES THE IMPROVEMENT OR CONSTRUCTION OF A PART OF ITS HIGHWAY SYSTEM WITHIN THIS COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH WHAT IS KNOWN AS HIGHWAY PROJECT F 58 SARGENT COUNTY, AND SUCH IMPROVEMENT OR CONSTRUCTION WILL REQUIRE THE ACQUISITION BY THE STATE OF LANDS FOR RIGHT OF WAY OR BORROW PITS WITHIN THIS COUNTY,

"BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED THAT THIS COUNTY PAY FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE ACTUAL COST OF SUCH LANDS, WHETHER ACQUIRED BY CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS OR BY DIRECT PURCHASES FROM THE OWNERS OF THE SAME INCLUDING SUCH SUMS AS MAY BE PAID AND ALLOWED SUCH OWNERS ON ACCOUNT OF DAMAGES TO IMPROVEMENTS, REMOVAL OF IMPROVEMENTS OR OTHER ALLOWABLE DAMAGES UNDER THE LAW OF EMINENT DOMAIN OF THIS STATE, INCLUDING LANDS ACQUIRED BY PURCHASE AT WHAT IS DEEMED A REASONABLE VALUATION BY THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT IF SAID LANDS TO BE ACQUIRED FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES ARE ACQUIRED BY THIS COUNTY OR ITS BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE STATE, AND PAID FOR WITH COUNTY FUNDS, THE COUNTY AUDITOR SHALL PRESENT, AS SOON AS CONVENIENTLY MAY BE AFTER SUCH PAYMENT, TO THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, PROPER VOUCHER FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO THIS COUNTY OF FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE COUNTY FUNDS SO EXPENDED THEREFOR; AND, IF SAID LANDS OR ANY OF THEM ARE ACQUIRED AND PAID FOR BY THE STATE, OR ITS STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT OUT OF STATE FUNDS, THEN THE COUNTY AUDITOR UPON PRESENTATION TO HIM OF A VOUCHER DULY CERTIFIED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY ENGINEER OF SAID STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, SHALL, AND HE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO DRAW AND DELIVER TO THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT DUE AND PROPER COUNTY WARRANT OF THIS COUNTY FOR FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE ACTUAL TOTAL COST OF SAID LANDS SO PAID FOR BY THE STATE OR ITS STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT.

ON ROLL CALL ALL MEMBERS PRESENT VOTED IN FAVOR OF SAID RESOLUTION, AND THE SAME WAS DECLARED DULY CARRIED AND ADOPTED.

DAN SMITH, STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT DISTRICT ENGINEER FROM VALLEY CITY, MET WITH THE BOARD IN REGARD TO MATTERS PERTAINING TO HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

COMMISSIONER DAWSON INTRODUCED AND MOVED THE ADOPTION OF THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARGENT COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA, WHEREAS CLAUD QUAST, INCOMPETENT, HAS BEEN FOR THE PAST SEVEN YEARS AND IS NOW A PATIENT AT THE STATE HOSPITAL, JAMESTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA, AND HAS BEEN AND IS NOW A CHARGE UPON THE SAID COUNTY AND WHEREAS THE SAID CLAUD QUAST OWNS THE NW 1/4 SECTION 1, AND ALL SEC. 33, TOWNSHIP 130, RANGE 58, SARGENT COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA.

NOW WHEREAS THE APPRAISED VALUE OF THE ABOVE DESCRIBED REAL ESTATE IS IN THE SUM OF \$6200.00 AND WHEREAS KEITH STALTER, THE ONLY, APPOINTED, AND QUALIFIED GUARDIAN OF THE ESTATE OF CLAUD QUAST, INCOMPETENT, DEEMS IT FOR THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE STATE THAT SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 130, RANGE 58, SAID SECTION 33 HAVING BEEN APPRAISED FOR \$3000.00 AS OWNED BY INCOMPETENT, CLAUD QUAST, BE SOLD. 



