THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET, PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT, WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

A TELEGRAM WAS RECEIVED FROM THE SURPLUS MARKETING ADMINISTRATION ANNOUNCING THAT SARGENT COUNTY HAD BEEN DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE AS AREA FOR THE FOOD STAMP PLAN TO OPERATE IN, NECESSITATING PROVISIONS BEING MADE FOR REVOLVING FUND FOR SAME.

OF 100 MOTION THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND COUNTY AUDITOR WERE AUTHORIZED AND INSTRUCTED TO ISSUE CERTIFICATE, ON THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND TO SARGENT COUNTY BANK FOR \$4,500.00, DUE IN ONE YEAR AT THE RATE OF 5%, THIS SUM TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AND TRANSFERRED TO THE SARGENT COUNTY FOOD STAMP PLAN REVOLVING FUND IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE AGREEMENT WITH THE SURPLUS MARKETING ADMINISTRATION.
