The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Jerry Waswick, David Jacobson, Sherry Hosford, Mike Walstead, and Bill Anderson. Also present was Paige Cary, The Sargent County Teller; and Pam Maloney, Sargent County Auditor.

Approve minutes of the July 5, 2016, commission meeting as corrected. (Walstead/Hosford, unanimous)

Lyle Bopp, State's Attorney; and Jayne Pfau, Assistant State's Attorney; arrived at the meeting.

Motion to adopt the Electronic Communications Device Policy resolution as presented as a result of discussions with employees & Verizon Wireless and a desire to have a uniform reimbursement policy for the use of personal ECD's for those eligible employees (said resolution being attached to these minutes: (Anderson/Walstead)

Motion to amend paragraph #11 in the resolution to read: The eligibility for reimbursement and the reimbursement rates established by this resolution shall be in effect from and after January 1, 2017, except for County Commissioners, who shall not be eligible for reimbursement until January 1, 2019. (Anderson/Walstead) Roll Call Vote: Yes – Walstead, Anderson & Waswick. No – Jacobson & Hosford. Motion to amend paragraph #11 passes.

Motion to amend the resolution to leave the current reimbursements as is. (Jacobson, died for lack of second)

Roll Call Vote: Yes – Walstead & Anderson. No – Jacobson, Hosford & Waswick. Motion to adopt resolution failed.

Sandra Hanson, Tax Director/911 Coordinator/Emergency Manager, arrived at the meeting. An Application for Abatement of Taxes was received from Steve & Janell McLaen, Forman, requesting abatement of taxes on a residence on the NE1/4 10-130-55 that is no longer livable. The applicants request that the value of the residence be changed to salvage value. The residence is in the process of some rehabilitation and will go back on the tax rolls as the work is done. The Rutland Township Board of Supervisors has approved the abatement application. Motion to concur with Rutland Township. (Walstead/Anderson, unanimous) Ms. Hanson also commented that FEMA auditors will be coming in August to audit 2011 FEMA monies.

Donna Eklund, county resident, arrived at the meeting.

Motion to adopt the following resolution. (Anderson/Walstead)

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson for Sargent County to affirm to North Dakota Public Employees Retirement System that Sargent County is formed pursuant to N.D.C.C § 11-01-01 & 11-01-42 and is neither a non-profit corporation nor a for-profit corporation, to join the NDPERS Defined Benefit Retirement Plan and offer the plan to all eligible employees of the agency. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Walstead. Roll Call Vote: Yes – Anderson & Waswick. No – Jacobson, Walstead & Hosford. Motion to adopt resolution failed.

Motion to adopt the following resolution. (Hosford/Anderson)

A motion was made by Commissioner Hosford for the Sargent County Sheriff's Department to affirm to North Dakota Public Employees Retirement System that the Sargent County Sheriff's Department is formed pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 11-10-02 and is neither a non-profit corporation nor a for-profit corporation, to join the NDPERS Law Enforcement Defined Benefit Retirement Plan and offer the plan to all eligible employees of the Sargent County Sheriff's Department. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. There was some discussion on whether it is possible to adopt the Law Enforcement Plan if the county hadn't adopted the Main Plan. Motion tabled until the next meeting.

Motion to appoint Sandra Hanson to the Planning Commission. Term ending June 14, 2020. (Anderson/Walstead, unanimous)

Commissioner Hosford reported that Alison Peterson has resigned as County Health Administrator with her last full day being August 5th, but she will continue to work on an hourly basis to finish up some work and help train her successor.

Motion to authorize the chairman and the auditor to sign the Construction Engineering Contract with Interstate Engineering for Project BRO-0041(012) (Hall Township Bridge Project). (Walstead/Jacobson, unanimous)

Road Supervisor Merrill Engquist arrived at the meeting. He stated that Mark Sand and Gravel has started the first phase of the road paving project on County Road #14.

Graveling projects are still in the process of completion throughout the county.

The commissioners asked if County Road #14 north of Geneseo has been maintained as was discussed at the June 7 commission meeting. Mr. Engquist reported that they have done some maintenance, but are still working on it. Dust control application will also be starting this afternoon and then continuing throughout the county as mag-chloride is available and graveling projects are completed.

There was more discussion on some stockpiled gravel that had black dirt/organic material/weeds in it. The Road Commissioner, States Attorney and County Engineer will confer on the County's options, and will contact the supplier about the material. County gravel specifications provide that road gravel shall contain no deleterious materials, and both black dirt and organic material are considered to be deleterious material rendering gravel unsuitable for use on a road surface.
