The Sargent County Board of Commissioners met at 10:45 a.m. following the meeting of the Sargent County Park Board. The following members were present: Jerry Waswick; David L Jacobson; Mike Walstead; Steven Wyum; and, Bill Anderson. Absent: None. Also present were: Paige Cary, of the Sargent County Teller; Sherry Hosford, County Auditor; and, Lyle R Bopp, States Attorney.

Harlan Klefstad, Forman met briefly with the Board to discuss installing a crossing with a culvert in the NW1/4-15-129-56 (adjacent to County No. 5). This land has been pasture, and there is currently no approach for 1.3 miles. This land is going to be tilled, and there is currently no access without crossing a neighbor's crop land. The Board will discuss the matter with Sparky Engquist, Road Supt. later today when he is scheduled to meet with the Board.

Sandy Hanson, Tax Director arrived at the meeting to present an Application for Abatement or Refund of Taxes from Dennis P Illies, Gwinner on 8.9 acres in SW1/4-21-132-55 for 2012 and 2013. The acreage was listed in the valuation program as 12.8 and actual acres is 8.9. Willey Township approved the change in acreage. Concur with Willey Township. (Walstead/Jacobson, unanimous)

Sandy Hanson, Brian Tayer and Marwood Klein, members of the Sargent County EMS Advisory Board updated the Board on information regarding the new EMT Fulltime position. No applications have been received and additional advertising is continuing for this position. An E Dispatch System has also been set up for Gwinner First Responders to assist with calls to the Forman Ambulance Squad. The squad is doing a 30 day trial of this service at \$75/month and a \$60 set up charge. The EMS Advisory Board will continue to update the Board on results of additional advertising for the EMT position.

The Homeland Security Fund has had a negative balance since April 2011 and according to emergency management director Sandy Hanson, her office has not been successful in finding where the bookkeeping error occurred. Sherry Hosford, County Auditor asked if the amount of the negative balance of \$4,701.34 could be transferred from the Disaster Assistance fund, where there have been Administrative Fees deposited, to the Homeland Security Fund, and suggested that this be done. Motion to transfer this amount out of the Disaster Assistance fund to the Homeland Security Fund to zero out the balance. (Anderson/Jacobson. Roll call. Aye: Jacobson and Anderson. Nay: Waswick, Walstead and Wyum. Motion failed) The Emergency Management Director's Office will continue to look for this bookkeeping error. The Commission established a November 1, 2014 deadline to make a decision on the status of the Homeland Security Fund.

The Board recessed at 12:15 for lunch.

The Board reconvened at 1:00.

The Market Survey appointment scheduled for 1:00 p.m. was rescheduled for September 2, 2014 as the information and analysis have not been completed by the Market Survey consultant. Gina Hillestad, representing the Personnel Board presented a recommendation of a 1.4% Cost of Living Adjustment for 2015 for county employees.

Sparky Engquist, Road Supt. updated the Board on projects, including: work on County # 14 south of Geneseo; gravel projects; patching asphalt; new motor graders; Gerald Baker Small Claim, which NDIRF had originally denied, but the Small Claims Court found for Mr. Baker, and the insurance company will pay the total cost of judgment which was \$2,037.45; bridge report completed and mailed on August 15th; loose rock on roads and broken windshield incident; and, further discussion on the request from Harlan Klefstad. The County's current policy is that the landowner may install a necessary approach according to the County's specifications at the landowner's expense, and the county will furnish a culvert, if needed. The consensus of the Board was that no additional action is required. Mr. Klefstad may install the approach at the appropriate location.

Sandy Hanson gave a brief summary on the Wild Rice River bridge located in Weber Township that involved FEMA dollars. The bridge, an old multi-plate culvert, had been washed out several years ago and the Township had decided to abandon the bridge, along with the road leading to it, and to upgrade a Township road as an alternative route for local property owners and residents. The project is complete and there is some county cost that will be submitted for reimbursement. The county commissioners had approved an expenditure of up to \$15,000 for this bridge abandonment and removal on August 9, 2013.

Lorraine Jacobson, Sargent County Coroner, met with the Board to submit her resignation after 16 years as County Coroner. Lorraine and her husband have retired, and are leaving the county within the next three to four weeks. The Board accepted Ms. Jacobson's resignation with regret and thanked her for her dedicated service to the county. (Walstead/Anderson, unanimous) Lorraine proceeded to present information to the Board on appointment of coroner; eligibility; individuals authorized to act in the absence of the coroner; and, reportable circumstances. She also provided statistics of the 71 total cases that she had attended to over the past 16 years. Lyle Bopp, States Attorney was asked to check on procedure for appointing a new coroner.
