Bond of Coroner Willis H. Bradley presented his Official Bond as Coroner for Sargent County with Albert F. Price and P. M. Chandler as sureties. Approved and ordered to be placed on file.

J. G. Bartlett appointed constable. On motion of C. C. Newman the board proceeded by ballot to appoint a constable for the second Justice District. Franklin G. Bartlett received one vote and A. McLeod one vote. A second ballot being taken Franklin G. Bartlett received two votes and was declared appointed constable for the second district.

Justice Bond William J. Hughes presented his bond as Justice of the Peace for the second Justice District with R. Linton and P. M. Chandler as sureties. Approved and ordered to be placed on file.
