Ordered that an appropriation be made from the road and bridge fund of Sargent Co, D.T., sufficient to purchase 2000 feet of lumber to bridge the Wild Rice river on range line between town 131, range 53 and town 131, range 54, the citizens of said neighborhood to build said bridge without further expense to the county.

Moved by J. H. Nicholson and seconded by Jens Pederson, and carried; that the chairman appoint a committee of three persons to meet at the Auditor's office in the county of Sargent at one o'clock P. M., on the 14th day of October, 1885 to act as a board of review to lay out a public highway commencing at the southwest corner of section 10, Town 132, Range 54, running from thence in a southeasterly direction on the most practicable grounds and on or near the present traveled road to the plough, thence in a southwesterly direction on or near the present traveled road, to the southeast corner of section 16, Town 132, Range 54. The chair appointed A. A. Faugstad, Charles Afdew and William Rytte, as a board of review to locate said road.

Moved and carried that the board adjourn until 8 o'clock A. M. on the 7th

Monday October 7th 1885. 8 o'clock A. M.

Board of County Commissioners met according to adjournment, members all present - but Barton.
