Seconded and carried. First ballot: Cady three, Norman one and one blank. Mr. Cady having received a majority of the votes was duly elected chairman for the year 1889. Cady in the chair.

Moved by Cheney and seconded by Christianson that the treasurer bond be fixed at forty thousand dollars. - - Carried.

On motion the bond of J. D. Yaiser for \$2000. was approved. On motion the register of deeds bond was fixed at eight thousand dollars.

On motion the bond of A. D. Price for \$8000. was approved. On motion the bond of the district attorney was fixed at one thousand dollars and the bond of J. E. Bishop as district attorney for one thousand dollars was approved.

On motion the bond of the county assessor was fixed at one thousand dollars and the bond of Theodore Johnson for \$1000. was approved. On motion the coroner's bond was fixed at one thousand dollars, and the bond of W. W. Bradley for \$1000. was approved.

On motion the bonds of the county justices of the peace was fixed at five hundred dollars and the bond of W. S. Wolfe was
