On motion the application and offer of the said State Finance Company was allowed and accepted and the County Auditor and County Treasurer are hereby authorized to abate, & cancel all taxes for 1895 and prior years and accept and issue proper receipts to the amount of \$500.00 in full payment and satisfaction for all taxes due and delinquent to the County for 1896 and subsequent years, providing that the said sum of \$500.00 is paid on or before the 1st day of April 1900 according to the provisions of the aforesaid application and offer.
