Offer of G.B. Norton on 2nd 3/4 Section in South West Twp

In the matter of the offer G.B. Norton, to pay the original taxes at 7% per annum from the date said taxes became delinquent, on certain lands comprising 2 3/4 sections in South West Township (129-58). On motion the Auditor was instructed to inform Mr Norton that the Board would allow him to pay the original taxes for 1898 and prior years at 7% together with the Sheriff's Fee (if any) in case of Tax Judgments Sale, providing said taxes are paid on or before March 1st 1901.

Report of J.E. Bishop State Atty

The report of J.E. Bishop as State Attorney for Quarter ending Sept 30th 1900 was presented, and reporting no monies received by him as such officer. On motion the report was accepted, adapted, and ordered placed on file.

Application for Bridge in Milnor Township (137-54)

In the matter of the petition for a bridge in Milnor Township (137-54). On motion Commissioner Johnson was instructed to visit and investigate the necessity of said bridge and report at the next session of the Board together with his recommendations on the matter.

Application for Abatement SE 1/4-14-129-58

In the matter of the application of Charles G. Beach by A.M. Green Agent for owner of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 14. Twp 129. R. 58 for the privilege of paying the original taxes at 7% in all cases when said land has been bid in by, or sold to County.

Allowed.

On motion the application was allowed with the following proviso: that in addition to the original taxes at 7% he shall pay the Sheriff's Fee (if any) (in case of Tax Judgments sale) and this offer is to apply only as to the 1895 and prior years taxes, and said payment to be made on or before Jan. 15th 1901. And the Auditor is hereby authorized to make settlement accordingly.
