Forman N. Dak December 12th 1900

The Board of County Commissioners of Sargent County met at the Office of the County Auditor in the Town of Forman, pursuant to adjournment.

Members present. Johnson, Seltzer, Intelhous and Phifer. The Chairman being absent, the Board was called to order by the Auditor.

On motion Mr Seltzer was elected Chairman pro tem.

On motion the regular order of business was transposed and the Board proceeded to hear petitions and applications as follows viz:-

J.E. Forsberg Judgment

John E. Forsberg appeared before the Board and presented a petition and ask that he be allowed to pay the sum of \$30.00 in full payment and satisfaction of a certain judgment in favor of Sargent County, said judgment being for seed wheat and entered on the 13th day of July, 1893.

It appearing to the Board that said Forsberg was a poor man with a large family to support and that he had been a resident of the County for many years and that his crops had been a failure for a large part of the time he has been in the County. On motion the offer of said Forsberg was accepted and the Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept said sum in full payment and satisfaction of said judgment.
