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The Board of County Commissioners of Sargrout County, North Dakota met at the office of the County Auditor, pursuant to Law. Present Messrs, Land, Straub, Stevens and Johnson.

abatement of P.P. Tax of Nelson & Arngquist.

P. J. Matteson appeared before the Board asking for an abatement of the personal property taxes for the year 1901, assessed against Nelson and Arngquist in Dunbar Township.

Mr. Johnson moved that said tax be reduced from \$17.11 to \$11.16, which motion prevailed.

Change of Polling Place, W.S. Hill.

Mr. Stevens moved that the polling place for White Stone Hill precinct be fixed at the school house in the Village of Swimmer. Which motion prevailed.

Weber.

Mr. Straub moved that the polling place for the precinct of Weber be moved from the school house to the town hall in the Village of Havana. Which motion prevailed.

Taylor.

Mr. Stevens moved that the polling place for Taylor precinct be changed from the Fairview Farm to the school house in District number one. Which motion prevailed.

Cargill assessment 1902, Reduced.

Mr. Johnson moved that the valuation of the Cargill elevator at Cayuga for the assessment of 1902 be reduced from \$2132.00 to \$1452.00. Which motion prevailed.

School Roll Refund.

On motion a school roll for the year 1901, paid by R. Wilcox in Sargrout Twp. was ordered refunded, Mr. Wilcox having paid a school poll in Braxton Twp.

Refundment to A.E. Saunders, 1900 tax on SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 - 27-30-53.

Mr. Straub moved that the sum of \$3.24 be refunded to A. E. Saunders, same being the amount of the 1900 tax paid on the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 sec 29, Twp 130, R. 53; said land having been government land up to July 12 - 1902. Which motion prevailed.

Tax abatement, lots 11-12, Blk 29 " 21-22 " 21 Town of Milnor.

Mr. Johnson moved that the application of Andrew Helgerson offering to pay the sum of \$60.00 in full settlement of all taxes held by the county against lots 11 and 12 of block 29 and lots 21 and 22 of block 21, Town of Milnor, be accepted, and the Auditor and Treasurer be authorized to make settlement accordingly. Which motion prevailed.

Refundment of 1889-90-91-92 taxes on lot 26, Blk 22, Town of Milnor.

Mr. Straub moved that the amount of the 1889, 1890, 1891 and 1892 taxes paid by J. T. Mc Nulty on lot 26 in block 22, Town of Milnor, with interest on same at 10% per annum from May 8th. 1894, be refunded to Mr. Mc Nulty, said taxes having been set aside and declared void by judgment of the District Court. Which motion prevailed.
