

Declaration of Emergency Sargent County

WHEREAS, Sargent County to include townships and communities, have suffered damages to it's infrastructure within its jurisdiction caused by spring melting, spring runoff, and rainfall. These conditions intensified due to wet conditions from late fall rains and spring ground frost at the time of our melting and rainfall;

WHEREAS, the impact of these damages are a threat to the health, well-being, and public safety of the citizens and traveling public as well as private and public property within Sargent County;

WHEREAS, the costs of repairs, replacements, and safety measures taken for the protection of such areas within Sargent County are exceeding the available resources of local townships, communities, and the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the board of Sargent County Commission declare that a State of Emergency does exist in the County of Sargent, North Dakota.
