The Silver Lake Park Board met for its regularly scheduled meeting at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 19, 2026. Those in attendance were Vice-Chairman Julie Colemer, Scott Johnson (electronically), Lyle Bopp, Jerry Waswick, and Wade Anderson. Also present were Tia Bopp, Auditor; and Garrett Cornelius, Park Manager. Absent from the meeting were Chairman Scott Christianson and Commissioner Jason Arth.

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman, Colemer at 8:01 a.m.

Motion to approve the agenda. (Waswick/Bopp) Motion carried.

Motion to accept the minutes from the April 21, 2026 meeting. (Anderson/Bopp) Motion carried.

Motion to approve financial report. (Anderson/Johnson) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Cornelius gave the following updates regarding the campground. Mulch was ordered through All Play Systems in Fargo for approximately \$3400.00 and should be available in about two weeks. The internet at the lake office has been installed and is working properly. Materials for the chemical recertification have been ordered and he is hoping to test before month end. He is working on getting updated quotes for the grant project. Cornelius has located the siren. He will ask more questions the next time Crossroads Electric is back on site.

In regards to new business a motion was made to refund the seasonal fee paid by Becky Manikowski. (Waswick/Anderson) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously. Manikowski is no longer able to use the open seasonal site.

Motion to approve a credit card for Garrett Cornelius. (Anderson/Johnson) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Kraft Slough. Garrett has done the mowing at both Kraft and Buffalo but did not put the porta potty out on Kraft. There outhouse at Buffalo is a permanent one. Dakota Septic has the porta potty out at Kraft. Discussion on who pays for the porta potty. Jerry is going to talk with the state as there has also been a request to mow a bigger parking spot.

Silver Lake Seasonal Rental Rules were discussed as a family was going to allow a sibling to move onto their lot. The current contract does not include language allowing siblings to take over a site. The language states spouse, parent, child or grandchild. Vice-Chairman Colemer, is looking for clarification on the wording. The board agreed they must follow the written policy, therefore, Colemer will get in contact with the family and let them know it cannot be sublet to a sibling.

Discussion on potential vending machines at the lake. We would have to have a contract written up and an agreement for the electricity. No action is being taken at this point.

Motion to pay the bills. (Anderson/Bopp) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:34 a.m.
