Approve October 7, 2008 minutes as read. (Anderson/Walstead, unanimous). Financial report showed a March 31, 2009 balance of \$51,433.93. (Hoistad/Waswick, unanimous)

Request the Sargent County Road Dept. blade that stretch of the township road from County Road #3 to the entrance of Silver Lake Park during the open season of the park. (Wyum/Hoistad) Roll call vote requested. AYE: Wyum, Hoistad, Anderson, Walstead, Waswick, Nelson. NAY: Orn. Motion carried.

Instructed Dennis to get information and cost of various utility vehicles to haul garbage containers, collect fees, and other uses and report at the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Dennis will contact Dickey Rural to purchase and activate the phone.

Dakota Valley Electric sent \$138.25 capital credit check, a letter that the application for Operation Round Up funds was denied due to lack of funds, and a letter about rate increase. The request to ND Game & Fish for cost share assistance for funding of a courtesy dock at Silver Lake was not approved. Garrison Diversion Conservancy District sent check in amount of \$6262.48 credited to the grant for swimming beach development at Silver Lake.

The following donations were received: \$200 from Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie No. 2749; \$250 from Wild Rice Antique Tractor & Plowing Assn.; \$500 from El Zagal Viking Patrol; \$100 from Tewaukon Rod & Gun Club; \$250 from American Legion Lawrence Berg Post 38. Two donation checks in the sum of \$3815.10 were presented from the Cogswell Gun Club by Richard Ruch.

The six seasonal camping sites are rented for 2009.
