The Sargent County Park Board met at 8:30 a.m. at the Sargent County Courthouse with the following present: James Peterson, Dave Jacobson, Jason Arth, Sherry Hosford, Mike Walstead, and Bill Anderson. Also present: Sue Seelye, Park Manager; and Pam Maloney, Sargent County Auditor. Absent was Julie Colemer.

James Peterson, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

Motion to approve the minutes of the July 17, 2018 meetings as presented. (Jacobson/Anderson, unanimous)

The financial statement showed a balance of \$95,117.29 in the Park Fund, and \$5,460.66 in the Kraft Slough Project fund. Approve financial report. (Hosford/Walstead) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Tibby Hinderlie, Sargent County Teller, arrived at the meeting.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Work is tentatively scheduled to begin next week on the addition to the shop.

Commissioner Hosford introduced the following resolution and made motion for it to be adopted: WHEREAS, Silver Lake Park is a popular recreational area in southeast North Dakota, serving thousands of residents and providing opportunities for fishing, swimming, boating, camping, picnics, other water-based recreational activities, and use of the Pavilion for receptions, reunions and other gatherings and WHEREAS, there is the need for additional and updated electrical and water hookup; WHEREAS, there is funding available from Garrison Diversion Conservancy District Recreation Grant program, NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sargent County Park Board request funding during the fall of 2018 grant application program for new electrical & water hookups and gravel for new pads to be placed on the southwest side on the hill; for a new electrical hookup on the north side where they is already water provided; & to update the electricity in the teardrop area on the southwest side. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent with the application for funding. Commissioner Jacobson seconded the motion, and on roll call vote, the resolution was duly declared carried and adopted.

Motion to approve the plan for gravel pads for the teardrop area & to order two belly dumps of gravel to create said pads. (Walstead/Hosford) Upon roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

There have been reports of some vandalism and thefts out at the park. Ms. Seelye was instructed to contact the sheriff's department to see if they have any game cameras that could be utilized.

The secretary was instructed to put the Silver Lake Seasonal Renter Rules on the Sargent County website.

Motion to lay new carpet at a cost of \$565 on the new boat dock received from the ND Game & Fish Department. There is carpet currently on it which is frayed in some areas & totally coming off in others. (Anderson/Walstead) Roll Call Vote: Yes – Arth, Jacobson, Anderson, Walstead & Peterson. No – Hosford.

Commissioner Hosford reported that there will be more discussion regarding the reparation or relocation of the Silver Lake Dam at the September 20, 2018, water resource board meeting if any of the county commissioners were interested in attending.

Commissioner Hosford inquired whether the humidity problem in the pavilion had been resolved. Ms. Seelye said that it had & that a thermostat and sensor had been replaced to take care of the issue.

NEW BUSINESS:

There were no donations received in July. There was \$14,605 camping fees collected and \$400 Pavilion rent for July.
